#### DESCRIPTIONS OF THE RESTRICTED FUNDS

**Lost River State Park Fund:** Created with \$2,000 donation in 2004. Fund will be used for improvemets as requested by the Superintendent of the Lost River State Park.

**Valley Falls State Park Fund**: Funded by a \$32,260.60 bequest from Ada Counts in 2005. Principal is restricted, accrued interest can be spent on Valley Falls State Park improvements per request of Park management.

**Chief Logan State Park Fund**: Created in 2005. Fund will be used for construction of a handicap children's playground in the Chief Logan State Park. Initial donations were from two fund raising events at the school in 2005.

**DNR Nature Centers & Environmental Programs Fund:** Created in 2005. Supported by income from sale of VIPP license plates and unrestricted donations to the Foundation. Spending decisions are made upon request of the WVDNR Parks Management. Lodging donations received from parks without foundations are placed in this Fund.

**Coopers Rock State Forest Fund**: Started with donation by Dr. Charles Stewart in 2006 for installation of a handicap accessible fountain. The fountain was installed in 2007.

Bluestone State Park Fund: Created in 2007. No activity as of December 31.

Blackwater Falls State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Cacapon State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Pipestem State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Seneca State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Panther State Forest Fund: Created in 2007. No activity as of December 31.

## Notes for the 2007 WVSPF Financial Report and comments on 2008 activity to date

## 2007

### 1. VIPP mailing:

The mailing cost us about \$2,200 (not including the cost of letterhead and brochures). The mailing generated 27 donations totaling \$2,720. Of that, \$2,320 was not designated for a specific park and was placed in the Nature Center Fund. Donations designated for other parks:

Cacapon 3 donations totaling \$150
Seneca State Forest 1 donation totaling \$25
Blackwater Falls 2 donations totaling \$125
Pipestem 1 donation totaling \$100

### 2008

#### 1. Lodging donations:

No lodging donations were received in 2007. However, through March 25, 2008 a total of \$216 has been received. Of that, \$192 was from Blackwater Falls and \$24 was from Seneca State Forest. All of the donations have been put in the Nature Center Fund.

#### 2. Bluestone memorial donation:

We received a \$1,020 donation in 2008 from the family of Charles Bennett to be used at the Bluestone State Park. A restricted fund has been created for Bluestone.

#### 3. Panther State Forest donation

We received a \$5,000 donation from the Cabot Oil and Gas Corp. to help pay for new playground equipment at the Panther State Forest. A restricted fund has been created for Panther.
