otes for the Restricted Funds Activity Report

- 1. Audra State Park received a \$3K grant from Barbour County to upgrade campground electric service.
- 2. Bluestone received a \$42.5K grant from Gulfstream West Investments for unspecified improvements.
- 3. \$14.6K was transferred from the Cashdollar Fund to the Tygart Lake Fund to help pay for construction of a nature-themed playground.
- 4. The Greenbrier State Forest received a \$50K grant from the Greater Kanawha Valley Foundation for construction of new trails. \$20K was spent to construct the trails in 2014.
- 5. Laurel Lakes WMA used most of their Fund to purchase tools for Park employees.
- 6. Nature Center Fund income included \$516 in lodging donations received at the following facilities:
 - Blackwater Falls State Park \$506 Seneca State Forest \$10
- (Note: State checks no longer show which park collected the donations so the above allocation may be incorrect).
- 7. Tygart Lake received \$250 in donations and spent \$705 on their annual "Hooked on Fishing, Not on Drugs" event.
- 8. Tygart Lake received a \$20K donation to construct a nature-themed playground and the Foundation has requested a \$7.5K DNR matching grant to help pay for the equipment. \$42K was spent on the playground and \$14.6K was transferred from the Cashdollar Fund to help pay for the playground. When the matching grant is received, the Tygart Lake Fund will have a positive balance of \$461.

General Notes to the Financial Report

- 1. Interest income is allocated to the restricted funds based on their average balance during the year. Funds with an average balance of \$400 or less do not get interest.
- 2. The Foundation received a \$166K bequest from the estate of Kenneth L. Cashdollar in 2011. To date, most of that money is unused and is awaiting projects for the maintenance, construction and improvement of hiking trails, overlooks, and nature centers in Blackwater Falls, Twin Falls, and Tygart Lake State Park.

West Virginia State Parks Foundation Description of the Restricted Funds

as of January, 2015

Audra State Park Fund: Created in 2008.

Blackwater Falls State Park Fund: Created in 2007. Donations and expenses were to purchase playground equipment in 2010.

Blackwater Video Fund: Created in 2011 to support the post-production work and marketing of the video "Blackwater Canyon: Portrait of the Wild Lands". Funding is from a grant from the WV Humanities Council.

Bluestone State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Cacapon State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Cashdollar Fund: created in 2011 with a \$166K bequest from the estate of Kenneth L. Cashdollar "for maintenance, construction and improvement of hiking trails, overlooks, and nature centers. Preference for Blackwater Falls, Twin Falls, or Tygart Lake State Park."

Chief Logan State Park Fund: Created in 2005. Fund will be used for construction of a handicap children's playground in the Chief Logan State Park. Initial donations were from two fund raising events at the school in 2005, but no activity since then.

Coopers Rock State Forest Fund: Started with donation by Dr. Charles Stewart in 2006 for installation of a handicap accessible fountain. The fountain was installed in 2007 and there has been minimal activity since then.

Droop Mountain Battlefield State Park: Created in 2013 to help fund a memorial plaque listing the soldiers killed in the Civil War battle of Droop Mountain.

DNR Nature Centers & Environmental

Programs Fund: Created in 2005. Supported by lodging donations and unrestricted donations to the Foundation. Spending decisions are made upon request of the WVDNR Parks Management.

Greenbrier State Forest Fund: created in 2008. Initial donations were for construction of a disk golf course and support of the shooting range. A \$50K donation was received in 2014 to support construction of additional trails.

Laurel Lakes WMA Fund: Created in 2012 to accept donations for the purchase of playground equipment at the WMA.

Lost River State Park Fund: Created with \$2K donation in 2004. There has been no activity since 2004.

Moncove Lake State Park Fund: Created in 2013.

Pipestem State Park Fund: Created in 2007.

Seneca State Forest Fund: Created in 2007.

Tygart Lake State Park Fund: Created in 2013. Initial purpose was to support the Park's annual "Hooked on Fishing, not on Drugs" event each spring. A \$20K donation was made in 2014 to partially fund a nature-themed playground.

Valley Falls State Park Fund: Funded by a \$32,260.60 bequest from Ada Counts in 2005. Principal is restricted, accrued interest can be spent on Valley Falls State Park improvements per request of Park management. The full balance in this Fund was transferred to the newly formed 501(c)(3) Valley Falls State Park Foundation on 2013. This Fund is now inactive

Watters Smith State Park Fund: Created in 2012 to accept donations for construction of a trail bike washing facility. It was completed in 2012.
